### **MINISTRY PASSAGES**

#### THE CHURCH

#### Ephesians 4:16 — The Body Causes the Growth of the Body

16 From whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by what every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love.

#### Matthew 28:19-20 — Make Disciples

- 19 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit,
- 20 teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

#### Matthew 18:15-20 — Church Discipline and Restoration

15	"If your brother sins, go and show him his fault in private; if he listens to you, you
	have won your brother.
16	"But if he does not listen to you take one or two more with you so that by the mouth

- 16 "But if he does not listen to you, take one or two more with you, so that by the mouth of two or three witnesses every fact may be confirmed.
- <sup>17</sup> "If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector.
- 18 "Truly I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall have been bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall have been loosed in heaven.
- 19 "Again I say to you, that if two of you agree on earth about anything that they may ask, it shall be done for them by My Father who is in heaven.
- 20 "For where two or three have gathered together in My name, I am there in their midst."

#### **DISCIPLINE 2 [THE HOME]**

#### Deuteronomy 6:4-9 — Love the Lord; Care for Your Home

- 4 "Hear, O Israel! The Lord is our God, the Lord is one!
- 5 "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.
- 6 *"These words, which I am commanding you today, shall be on your heart."*
- 7 "You shall teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up.
- 8 "You shall bind them as a sign on your hand and they shall be as frontals on your forehead.
- 9 "You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.
