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#### **Ephesians 6:4** — **PARENTING**

Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of 4 the Lord.

#### **Deuteronomy 6:6-9 — TEACH DILIGENTLY**

- 6 These words, which I am commanding you today, shall be on your heart.
- 7 And you shall repeat them diligently to your sons and speak of them when you sit in your house, when you walk on the road, when you lie down, and when you get up.
- You shall also tie them as a sign to your hand, and they shall be as frontlets on your forehead. 8
- You shall also write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates. 9

#### Proverbs 13:24 — LOVE YOUR CHILDREN

He who withholds his rod hates his son, but he who loves him disciplines him diligently. 24

#### Proverbs 22:15 — RESCUE YOUR CHILDREN FROM FOOLISHNESS

Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child; The rod of discipline will remove it far from him. 15
