**Definition:** God's goodness in withholding punishment over a period of time toward those who sin. God's wrath delayed.

# THE WRATH OF GOD

**Definition:** God intensely hates all sin and will express that hatred in judicial punishment of all wrongdoing as a right and necessary reaction to evil.

• Nahum I:2

• Isaiah 53:5-11

• Revelation 20:11

The wrath of God is his eternal detestation of all unrighteousness. It is the displeasure and indignation of divine equity against evil. It is the holiness of God stirred into activity against sin. - **A. W. Pink, The Attributes of God**

# THE GRACE OF GOD

**Definition:** God's goodness manifested toward the ill-deserving. It is unmerited favor. A free gift to those who don't deserve it.

#### **Common Grace**

- Psalm 145:9
- Romans 13

#### **Saving Grace**

• Ephesians 2:4-9

Grace is a provision for men who are so fallen that they cannot lift the ax of justice, so corrupt that they cannot change their own natures, so averse to God that they cannot turn to Him, so blind that they cannot see Him, so deaf that they cannot hear Him, and so dead that He Himself must open their grace and lift them into resurrection. **G. S. Bishop** 

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#### Manifestations of God's Grace in the Believer:

- I. Grace supplies the gift of ministry (Romans I:5)
- 2. Grace provides material and spiritual blessings (II Corinthians 9:8)
- 3. Grace sustains in the midst of affliction (II Corinthians 12:9)
- 4. Grace will glorify believers at the 2nd coming (I Peter 1:13)
