- The produce of a life led by the Spirit [**Galatians 5:16-18; 22-26**]
 - Not carrying out the desires of the flesh
 - Not under the law
 - Love
 - Joy
 - Peace
 - Patience
 - Kindness
 - Goodness

 - Gentleness
 - Self-control
 - The flesh has been crucified
 - The believer walks in step with the Spirit
 - The believer does not live for self-glory

MINISTRY PASSAGES

DISCIPLINE 1 [THE HEART]

Galatians 3:2-3 — BEGUN BY THE SPIRIT BY HEARING WITH FAITH

- 2 *This is the only thing I want to find out from you: did you receive the Spirit by the works of the Law, or by hearing with faith?*
- 3 *Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh?*

Galatians 5:16 — WALK BY THE SPIRIT

- 16 *But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.*

Romans 8:12-13 — BE PUTTING TO DEATH THE DEEDS OF THE BODY

- 12 *So then, brethren, we are under obligation, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh—*
- 13 *for if you are living according to the flesh, you must die; but if by the Spirit you are putting to death the deeds of the body, you will live.*

Galatians 5:19-21 — THE EVIDENCE OF FLESHLY DESIRES/DEEDS OF THE FLESH

- 19 *Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality,*
- 20 *idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions,*
- 21 *envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.*

Galatians 5:22-23 — THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT

- 22 *But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,*
- 23 *gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.*
